

What Should I Wear?

Whatever you like, we will provide the safety helmet, but it doesn't hurt to have a change of clothes. The paintballs used at Paintball Paradise wash out with water, but you will most likely get dirty. We do have coveralls available for rent for only \$5 if you prefer we do the laundry. Heavier, baggy clothing can also help to lessen the impact of the paintball. Proper closed toe and heel footwear is required. No Crocks or Sandals!

Does It Hurt?

We won't lie a paintball can sting, a little. At worst it's like a snap from a rubber band, and the 1/2 splat option more like a flick of the finger, but when the adrenaline is flowing it's hardly noticeable. You might get a bruise, that won't last long though. If your worried you can request that your groups guns be turned down.

Do I Need To Sign A Waiver?

Yes. All players must sign a waiver and players under the age of 18 must have **their parent** or legal quardian's consent on the form. You can find our waiver at www.paintballparadise.com. Players over 18 will need to present ID when checking in.

What If The Weather Is Bad?

We have both indoor and outdoor play fields with viewing areas at our facility. The weather won't affect your party and we're open rain, snow or shine, night or day. The outdoor fields are open in the winter as well, so dress accordinly if you want play the outdoor courses in the colder months.
